Hello everyone,

If only life were as idyllic as this! While we were in Ethiopia, we had only one 8 oz. bottle of water a day rationed since we had decided to carry with us as much as we could for the street children in Addis Ababa. That meant that by the time we got to the last day of the mission trip we were out of water and dry, dry, dry. The thing was, if we drank some of our bottled water, it didn't make any real impact on our thirst. We couldn't risk the local water, and the water out of the tap had sand in it. To boot, I got up at 5:30 a.m. only to find that there was absolutely no water at all in the hotel. Only after some local men complained did we get a bit above a trickle by 6:10 a.m.



Why do I tell you this? Because water around the world is a real problem. Oh, yes, we have oceans and wells and who knows what, but drinkable water is something else. And when people are thirsty, they may let the boundaries of self-control crumble just to end the discomfort of a parched mouth and dehydration



They may just drink anything, even it might kill them.

Which leads me to say that when I prayed about all this, I caught the vision of EnGedi, the stream of living water God provided David in the desert place of Israel. EnGedi represents refuge, a hiding place in the crags of the rocks, a place where the waters flowed freely. God invites anyone who thirsts for living waters to come to Christ and drink freely without cost. Living waters represent the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Life. And we are to seek out EnGedi that we might live and not die.
